First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter's sermon in the Temple area ends any ignorance on the people's part of Jesus' true identity, and targets the awful way they acted before Pilate. He calls for repentance and conversion.

Second Reading: I John 2:1-5a

Here we have the biblical viewpoint on what "knowing God" really means. It is keeping His commandments. God's love for us is the source of the love for Him that we have in our hearts.

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

Jesus' victory over death is symbolized by His simple act of eating a meal again with His disciples. His message will go out to the world through His disciples and eventually through us.
