Second Sunday of Advent December 7, 2014

First Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11

The prophet receives his commission amid the imaginary scene of the heavenly council meeting. He is to let Jerusalem (i.e. the Israelites) have proof of God's concern for them. There will soon be a new exodus, led by the Lord's Son.

Second Reading: II Peter 3:8-14

The undated but definite coming of "the day of the Lord" has the earmarks of a thief in the night. So it is incumbent on the disciple to be prepared for it.

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

This prologue section offers the basis for the good news, namely the Jesus story. Then the author quickly moves on to John the Baptist's activity, the climax of which will be the baptism and announcement of Jesus' arrival.
