#### First Reading: Acts 2:1-11

We are presented here with two scenes of the Spirit at work: at the "house", and at some unknown large space able to hold "a large crowd." His activity emboldens the disciples, and allows people from many countries to understand them despite the usual language barrier.

#### Second Reading: I Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13

Paul writes against any spiritual snobbery among his readers by attributing the gift of faith entirely to the Holy Spirit's action. The diverse gifts among the community coalesce in their service to the group.

#### Gospel: John 20:19-23

The sudden appearance of Jesus in the locked room brings peace to the frightened disciples, and fills them with joy. The scars left by His suffering still show on Jesus' glorified body, as He talks of an outpouring of mercy upon all sinners.
