The 27th. Sunday in Ordinary Time October 2, 2016

First Reading: Habakuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4

In a dialogue with God, the prophet questions how to react to all the suffering happening in the world. The Lord responds that keeping fidelity and trust in God is the way to live.

Second Reading: II Timothy 1:6-8

Paul reminds Timothy of his calling to spread the faith as his legitimate official mission. He must never be ashamed of the Gospel.

Gospel: Luke 17:5-10

Disciples must have an unwavering faith in Jesus, which can bring about the unexpected outcome in many instances. That faith can rescue them from doubt when dealing with strong opposition. At the same time they are to work for the Lord without making the Lord obligated to them.

50th Anniversary of our Parish 5.00 PM, Saturday, October 8, 2016

From the historical documents preserved in the parish office, I learned the following: Word of new parish of St. Boniface first appeared in a short blurb in the Catholic News and a few placards in local store windows. The Rev. John P. Keogh was appointed Pastor. The first Masses were celebrated on June 19, 1966 in the Ivy Manor Restaurant, with approximately one hundred families participating.

An ad hoc council was quickly assembled, and meetings were held to determine a more suitable place for religious services. Attention soon focused on St. Rita's Chapel, a little-used building visible through scrub growth on Route 306. It was conveniently located in a central area of the proposed parish, and more over, a parking lot was accessible across the road. In spite of the snow and howling blizzard, on Christmas day in 1966, the same structure of St. Rita's Chapel that was expanded for CCD classes and Rectory was blessed and Father Keogh was officially installed as Pastor.

In 1973, the parish rejoiced when Father Keogh became Monsignor Keogh, but it soon was saddened to learn of his transfer to St. Clare's in Staten Island. Fr. Joseph Boyd became the Pastor of St. Boniface Parish in December that year. On April 20 a groundbreaking ceremony was held amid great excitement in the property owned by the Archdiocese to build the current Church of St. Boniface on April 20, 1980.

Msgr. Joseph Boyd, who envisioned the new facility, wrote in the dedication Journal: "The success of a task belongs to God. By using the parishioners and their talents as instruments in building this edifice, He brought us closer together as we labored for is Honor and Glory". On June 28, 1981, The Late His Eminence Cardinal Terence Cooke autographed these words beneath his own picture that he gave to our parish to commemorate that great day for all future times: "To Father Joseph Boyd and all God's people in St. Boniface Church, with a blessing to you and your loved ones; Happy Dedication day!"

Now, after 50 years, we are standing at the threshold of big changes in the nature and existence of our parish church. We share our building with the Syro Malabar Rite with a mutual sense of dependence and spirit of sharing. On October 8, at 5.00 PM, we all will come together to offer the Golden Jubilee Thanksgiving Holy Eucharist presided by our beloved Archbishop Cardinal Timothy Dolan. We will have a potluck dinner reception thereafter in the newly renovated Fr. Boyd hall. I welcome each and every one of you to participate in that joyful celebration.
